with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount due by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and not further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

same land this day conveyed to me by J. Lee Greene and this
mortgage is given to secure the purchase money, being the same
land conveyed to J. Lee Greene by Mrs H. E. Allis, June 27, 1919
