State aforesaid in Gantt Township, containing $59 \frac{2}{3}$ acres, more or less and being known as tract number

is situated on both sides of Grove Road and adjoins
land of John F. Granger et al. Being the same tract
of land conveyed by J. M. Swain to Owen Farrell by
his deed of conveyance bearing date March 6, 1915 and

Book 39 at page 121.
