SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said R. S. Eaton  
in and by May certain, for value received,  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to  
Charley J. Cloekler  
in the full and just sum of Sixty Five Hundred and Fifty (\$655.00)  
Dollars, to be paid February 1st, 1920  
with interest thereon from February 1st, 1920 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
then foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent  
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said R. S. Eaton,  
in consideration of the said said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
Charley J. Cloekler  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said  
R. S. Eaton  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Charley J. Cloekler

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Charley J. Cloekler

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated,  
lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of  
Greenville, State aforesaid, same being a portion of the  
Rowdy land and having the following metes and bounds  
to wit:

Commencing at a stake on East Avenue and running  
thence N. 8° E. eighteen feet and eight inches to a stake  
corner of East Avenue and Mc Gee Street, S. 21° 45' E. one  
hundred and sixty-two feet and six inches to a stake  
on Mc Gee Street and lot No. 45; thence along line  
of lot No. 45 in a Westerly direction fifty-one feet and  
eight inches to a stake; thence W. 21° 45' N. one hundred  
and fifty-two feet and six inches to a stake on  
East Avenue the beginning corner.

Being the same lot of land Conveyed to W. D. Parrish  
and W. Q. Conyers by Thos T. Goldsmith by deed recorded  
in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 11, page  
189, and from W. D. Parrish and W. Q. Conyers to R. G. Chest-  
nut by deed bearing date November 4th 1911, and recorded  
in Vol. 15, page 475 of the R. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County; and from R. G. Chestnut to Charley J. Cloekler  
by deed bearing date September 15th, 1914, and recorded  
in Vol. 24, page 573 of the C. M. C. Office for Greenville  
County, and being the same land conveyed to me by  
Charley J. Cloekler by deed of even date not yet rec-  
orded.
