All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, Greenville County on waters of Musa Creek in Saluda Township, about 16 miles from the City of Greenville and marked lot, No. 5 in the division of the Real Estate of Benjamin Boswell, deceased, containing 20 acres, more or less bounded by lands of William W. Drimney, lot No. 4, and others and runs as follows: Beginning at a stone on William W. Drimney's line and running thence N. 43° 34' E. 30 chains to a stone on branch corner of lot No. 4; thence down branch 2.35 chains to a small Poplar 5 ft. n. n.; thence S. 32° 17'. 13.58 chains to a stone on William W.
