until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of the whole
amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said H. R. Schalf

All that following lots land situated, lying
and being in the State of South Carolina and county aforesaid
near the city of Greenville now the northwest side
of Endel Street bounded as follows: - Beginning, at
an iron pin on the northwest margin of Endel
Street, 150 feet across Stradley Street at the northeast
corner of lot no. 4 of the plat of the Willimow land,
which plat is duly recorded in plat book "A" at
page 506 - Book C. Office for Greenville County, and runs
thence with the northwest margin of said Endel
Street 3.23.24 E. 150 feet to an iron pin, at the
S.E. corner of lot no. 16 of said plat; thence N. 67.30
W. with the S.W. line of said lot no. 16, 100 feet to
an iron pin at the S.E. corner of lot no. 10 of
said plat; thence S. 23.24 W. with the S.E. end lines
of lots 5, 6 and 5 of said plat, 150 ft. to an iron pin,
at the N.W. corner of lot no. 3 of said plat; and
thence S. 67.30 with the N.E. end lines of lots 3 and
4 of said plat 99 7/8 feet to the beginning corner, being
lots 17, 18 and 19 of said Willimow plat, mentioned
