actually collected.

not, according to the true intent and meaning of the said note, then this deed of bargain and sale shall cease, determine, and be utterly null and void; otherwise

in full force and virtue.

AND IT IS AGREED, by and between the said parties, that the said mortgagor is to hold and enjoy the said

premises until default of payment shall be made.
