All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, on the West side of the Pelham Road, leading to the town of Green, and has the following courses, metes, bounds and distances, to wit: Beginning at a stone in the Pelham Road on line of lot No. 1 of subdivision of J. P. Smith, deceased East, and runs thence with said Road due South 805 feet to a bend in Road; thence S. 9 1/2 E. 740 to a stake in said Road; thence S. 65 N. 12.5 Feet to the center of Buncombe Road; thence N. 41 3/4 W. 142 feet to the T Roads; thence N. 38 1/4 W. with the old Road 867 feet to the corner of lot No. 4 of said division; thence N. 35 E. 990 feet to a stone corner of lot no. 1, same division; thence S. 82 E. 470 feet to the beginning corner and contains Twenty Four and 84/100 Acres, more or less, known as tract No. 3 and a small portion of tract no. 2 as described on map made by F. S. Dodger, bearing date of Sept. 3rd 1909 of said division bounded by J. A. Wood, J. H. Green, Being the same tract of land I deeded to me this day by J. M. Wood and Bessie Wood.
