WHEREAS, I, the said Virginia G. Budgin,
in and by my certain promise
even date with these presents, well and truly indebted to,

Farmers and Merchants Bank, a corporation under
the laws of the State of South Carolina
in the full and just sum of One Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars,

Dollars, to be paid Six (6) months after date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid Annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or

interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent of the amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same is placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Virginia G. Budgin,
in consideration of the said said note and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Farmers and Merchants Bank,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Virginia G. Budgin, in hand well and truly paid by the said Farmers and Merchants

Bank, at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Farmers and Merchants Bank, its successors

or assigns forever, all that piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, being known and designated as lot No 44 on a plat of lands known as Townes Street property, said plat made by Wm. D. Neves b. 8 October 1919, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S.C. in plat book of Cleveland & Williams, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on west side of Townes Street, joint corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence along the line of lot No. 3 N. 76. 21. 200 feet to an iron pin on a fourteen foot alley; thence along the line of said alley N. 14 E. 60 feet and 5 inches to an iron pin, joint corner of lots nos. 4 and 5; thence along line of lot No. 5 S. 76 E. 207 feet and 4 inches to an iron pin on Townes Street; thence along the line of said Townes Street S. 21. 06. 1 feet to the beginning corner, being the land conveyed to me by David Kohn, Trustee, by deed dated May 9, 1919 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol 50 page 338.

This is a third mortgage being junior to a first and second mortgage executed by me to the Home Building and Loan Association to secure the payment of \$4000.00 and \$3000.00 respectively.
