SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said Lawrence Watson Shelor

even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of One thousand dollars
Dollars, to be paid one year from date

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent of the

amount due upon this note besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings (any kind of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said

W. J. Headges
all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land, situate,
lying and being in the State of South Carolina,
in the County of Greenville in the First Ward of the City
of Greenville, known and designated as lot No. 10, on
plat dated February 1st, 1915, and recorded in
Office of Clerk of Court of said County and State in
plat book 6, at page 243, and having according to
said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:
Beginning at a stake on the Southeast corner of
Burlington Avenue (formerly known as Parlington St)
and Calhoun St running thence along said
Burlington Ave. S. 78.45 E 50 ft to a stake on corner of
lot No. 9; thence along line of last mentioned lot
N. 16.15 W. 155 ft to stake on a 15 foot alley; thence
along line of said alley N. 78.45 E 50 ft to a stake on
the east side of Calhoun St, thence along said St
N. 10.15 E. 175 ft to the beginning corner, and being
the same lot of land conveyed to me by G. W. Headges
