Apalache mill N. 0'-30" E. 441 ft. thence N. 11-50 E. 143 feet;  
thence N. 0'-30" E. 220 feet along said road to the corner  
of lot # 5 and # 6; thence N. 0'-30" E. 220 feet along said  
road; thence N. 7-05 N. 211 feet; thence N. 7-40 E. 283 feet  
to corner of W. P. Vaughn and lot # 5, thence N. 88-20  
W. 300 feet to corner of W. P. Vaughn; thence S. 14-20  
E. 258 feet to a stone; thence S. 19-15 N. 852 feet to  
stake; thence S. 26-30 N. 358 feet to a corner on stone,  
thence S. 86-0 N. 56 feet to stake on road leading to
