with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, and same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

in hand well and truly paid by the said

R. L. Ford and J. I. Smith
at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said R. L. Ford and J. I. Smith.

All that lot of land situate in the State and
County aforesaid near the town of Greer and
having the following metes and bounds:
Beginning at the corner of lot # 3 on the National
Highway and runs thence with said Highway
N. 87. 25 E. 71 feet to the corner of lot # 5; thence
along the line of lot # 5 S. 16. 20 W. 200 feet to the
line of lot # 10; thence along the line of lot # 10
S. 87. 25 W. 71 feet to the corner of lot # 3; thence
along the line of lot # 3 N. 16. 20 E. 200 feet to the
beginning corner known as lot # 4.

Also all that other lot of land adjoining the
above described lot and known as lot # 5, having
the following metes and bounds: Beginning at
the corner of lot # 4 on National Highway and
runs thence with said Highway N. 87. 25 E.
