SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I am, the said R. S. Davidow
in and by my certain (4) promissory note, 5 in writing, of
even date with these presents, I am well and truly indebted to

Claude J. Campbell, by my four promissory notes
bearing this date Seventy five hundred and fifty Dollars
in the full and just sum of
Dollars, to be paid On November 29th 1920, \$200.00 (Nov. 29th 1921)
\$200.00 on Nov. 29th 1922, \$200.00 on Nov. 29th 1923
\$150.00

with interest thereon from November 19th 1919 at the rate of 7% per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest is at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and enforce this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Fifty Dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said R. S. Davidow

in consideration of the said said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said
Claude J. Campbell
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said
R. S. Davidow

in hand well and truly paid by the said Claude J. Campbell

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said Claude J. Campbell, of Greenville

County, S. C. All that piece or parcel of land with a
dwelling thereon said lot, and situated lying and
being in the State of South Carolina, in the County of
Greenville, and in the Township of Greenville, at short
distance north west of the corporate limits of Greenville
S. C. and near the lands of the F. W. Poe Manufg. Co.
and the American Spinning Co. and designated as
lot number seven accord - to a survey made by
the late H. A. Hudson, and having according to such
survey the following meters and bounds respectively
to-wit: - Beginning at a stake on Gilreath Street, and
running thence along said Street N. 69 1/2 W. Sixty-six
and two-thirds (66 2/3) feet to a stake on lot number
8 thence S. 21 1/2 W. One hundred and eighty-three (183) feet
and eleven inches along line of lot number 8 to
a stake on said ten foot alley; thence S. 88 7/8 E.
Sixty-six and two thirds (66 2/3) feet along said
alley to a stake on the corner of lot number 6,
