Dollars, to be paid one note of \$1320.00 one year after date; one note of \$1240.00 two years
after date; one note of \$1160.00 three years after date and one note of \$1080.00 four
years after date

with interest thereon from maturity of said notes at the rate of 8 per cent, per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to be interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent on the amount due and unpaid besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney in collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.
