sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to

the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
hereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Samuel M. Vaughan
in consideration of the said said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said M. P. Brown.

All those two certain tracts or parcels of land situate about five miles east of the city of Greenville, County and State aforesaid on the Scaffletown Road known as tracts no. one and two respectively in a division of the lands of J. A. Greer, as shown on plat of same by W. D. Neves, Engineer, Oct. 10, 1912, and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Tract No. one: - Beginning at a stone on Scaffletown Road near the five mile branch, and running thence South 25.30 W. 2.65 to a stone; thence S 58.10 W. 2.56 to a stone in the five mile branch; thence S. 25.50 E. 19.86 to a stone on Settlement Road; thence with said road N. 15.20 E. 14.00 to a stone in bend of the road; thence N. 17.20 E. 7.22 to a stone on the Scaffletown road; thence with the Scaffletown road at junction of Settlement Road; thence S. 87.30 E. 10.75 to a cedar; thence Eastwardly to a red oak; thence S. 10.40 W. 3.52 to a stone; thence S. 15.40 W. 6.92 to S. Oak; thence S. 19.20 W. 2.82 to Red Oak; thence S. 32.40 W. 3.92 to a stone; thence S. 10.10 W. 13.25 to a stone corner; thence S. 66.30 W. 5.70 to a stone; thence N. 25.50 W. 13.11 to a stake on Settlement road; thence with Settlement road N. 15.20 E. 14.00 to a stake in said road; thence N. 17.20 E. 7.22 to the beginning stone, containing 35.15 acres more or less, and being the same tract of land conveyed to me by Zora L. Ridgeway by deed dated Jan. 3rd 1920, deed not yet recorded.
