with interest thereon from date at the rate of 6% per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (one of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, Lena W. Stone, the said Lena W. Stone

W. E. Scott, do hereby bind myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns, to pay to me, the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

Lena W. Stone, in hand well and truly paid by the said W. E. Scott.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said W. E. Scott,

all those three certain pieces, parcels or tracts of land in the State and County before aid and described as follows:  
with First tract, Being in Ward 6 of the City of Greenville fronting on the west side of Augusta Street and having the following metes and bounds to wit, beginning at an iron pin on Augusta Street at corner of J. E. Payne's lot and running thence with Augusta Street 838<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> N. 44 feet 8 inches to an iron pin, corner of McBrayce's lot, thence with McBrayce's line 3.61<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> N. 119 feet 6 inches to an iron pin, thence with Susan J. Hill's line N. 55<sup>7</sup>/<sub>8</sub> E. 100 feet to an iron pin, corner of J. E. Payne's lot, thence with said J. E. Payne's line 8.51<sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub> E. 87 feet 8 inches to the beginning corner, containing 8960 square feet, more or less and being the same lot conveyed to me this day by W. E. Scott and others.

Second tract, all that tract of land about 3 miles from Greenville Court House and about 300 feet north of the concrete road and beginning at a point at the intersection of Wedgwood Ave. and an un-named street and running thence in a northerly direction

with Wedgwood Avenue 314 feet to a stake, thence N. 43-30' W. 298 feet to a pin in said un-named street, thence with said un-named street in a southerly direction 482 feet to the beginning corner and containing 1.29 acres, being lot 720.21 of a plat of "Brookstone" acres, said plat recorded in R. M. C. office in Plat Book 6, pages 35-36.

Third tract, all that lot of land situate in the north side of West Earle Street and fronting on said Earle Street 100 feet and running back a distance of 416 feet to Croft Street and being lot 720.6 of a survey made by W. D. Nevel, April 7, 1915 and being the same lot conveyed to me by A. G. Stone, Aug. 1st, 1917. It is understood and agreed that the second and third tracts have a mortgage of \$8500 and this mortgage is a second and a junior mortgage to the \$8500 mortgage over said two tracts.
