Dollars, to be paid one year after date

with interest thereon from August 1st 1924 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time paid due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said C. F. Putman

aforesaid on the Augusta Road, about five miles
below the City of Greenville and being a por-
tion of the lands this day conveyed to Robert
Sullivan by Thomas Cooper and being more specifi-
cally described as follows:- Beginning in the Center
of the Augusta Road at the intersection of a field
road and running thence with said road N. 64-13
E. 49.0 to bend in road; thence N. 66-48 E. 7.80 to bend
thence N. 67-48 E. 7.06 to an iron pin in edge of
said road; thence N. 6-45 W. 8.31 to a stone; thence N.
73-10 E. 3.26 to an iron pin; thence N. 10-58 W. 12.84
to an iron pin; thence S. 63-10 W. 33.00 to center of Augusta
