All that piece, parcel and lot of land  
situate in the county of Greenville, South Carolina,  
as shown on plat of the Judeon Mills, being  
designated on said plat as lot no. 8. Said lot  
has the following metes and bounds: a frontage  
of 109 feet on the 20 foot road running  
Southeast and north west, thence northeast  
700 feet to an iron pin at the track of the  
Southern Public Utilities co. thence northwest  
380 feet along track of the Southern Public  
Utilities company to an iron pin; thence south-  
east 360 feet to an iron pin on the 20-foot road;
