All that piece, parcel or tract of land situate lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina on
or the Buncombe Road, and having the following courses and
distances to-wit: Beginning at a stone on right bank of branch
near a persimmon tree, thence down branch as a line 12.07
chs. to stake; thence N. 37 1/2 E. 7.72. chs. to an iron pin in the
Buncombe Road; thence along said road N. 57 W. 15.55 chs. to
an iron pin in center of road (over a concrete culvert) thence
S. 26 W. 7.69 chs. to the beginning corner, containing eleven
and 6/10 acres more or less, and being the same tract of land
conveyed to J. I. McKinney by W. D. Ballentine by deed dated
May 20, 1911 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville
County in Vol. 11 page 550. All that certain piece, parcel or
