sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Five per cent
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

in consideration of the said said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said T. R. Fowler

all that piece parcel and tract of land lying and
being situated in the County and State aforesaid and
being known and designated as tract no. 1 upon a
plat of the R. d. Andros land, said plat being Recorded
in the Office of the R. m. c. for Greenville County and this
said parcel being more specifically described as
follows: Beginning at a stake on Enoree River at a
corner of tract No. 3 in said survey and running thence
n. 67-50 E. 208 feet to corner of tract No. 2; thence n.
67-50 E. 4023 feet to a stake on the Buncombe Road
thence S. 20 1/2 E. 77 feet to a bend in said road; thence
S. 25 E. 300 feet to a bend in said road, thence S.
32-15 E. 200 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 67-50 W.
4174 feet to Enoree River, thence along Enoree River
to the following corner and containing 52.40 acres
more or less said being a portion of the lands
conveyed to me by R. d. Andros.
