bargain, sell and release unto the said William Goldsmith General Agent

All that certain lot of land situate in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, near Morgan Hill, comprising a part of lot no. 88 of Morgan Hill, the plat of which subdivision is recorded in P. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "A", page 70, and more particularly described as follows: Beginning at any iron pin on north side of Summit Street at the south west corner of lot no. 88, as shown on said plat, and running thence with Summit Street in an easterly direction 45 feet to a 29 foot street, known as Langdon Street; thence along the western side of said Langdon Street in a northerly direction to a point at right angles to Summit Street, which is 125 feet from Summit Street; thence in a westerly direction along line parallel with Summit Street to a stake on western line of lot no. 88; thence with the western line of lot no. 88 in a southerly direction to the beginning corner, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by A. W. Brewer by deed dated Jan. 19, 1920, deed not yet recorded.
