at Greenville South Carolina  
after date

with interest thereon from April 5th at the rate of seven per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of the said

amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by any attorney, or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto made, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Mrs. S. C. Mills

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate  
lying and being on the Northwest Corner of Mills  
Avenue and Dadson Street just outside the incorporate  
limits of the city of Greenville in the County and State  
aforesaid and known and designated as lot No. 19  
of Block "C" of the D. P. Mills property as shown on  
plat recorded in Plat Book "C", page 284 and having  
the following metes and bounds to-wit:-

Beginning at an iron pin corner of Mills Avenue  
and Dadson Street and running thence with Dadson  
Street N. 35.26 E. 180.4 feet to iron pin corner of lots No.  
20 of said block; thence with line of lot No. 20 S. 45.27  
E. 59.4 feet to an iron pin corner of lot No. 18; thence
