SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we, the said J. P. Hall and Hattie Hall  
in and by our certain Obligation or note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to

Campdown Mills  
in the full and just sum of One Thousand (1000.00)  
Dollars, to be paid One day after date thereof

with interest thereon from date thereof at the rate of Seven per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid quarterly  
until paid in full; all interest when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said ~~note~~ further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent on said amount besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note collectable as a part thereof. The same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, the legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Campdown Mills

All that certain piece parcel and lot of land situate, lying and being in Ward  
four (4) of the City of Greenville in the county and State aforesaid. Beginning  
at an iron pin one hundred and Seventy-one (171) feet from Paul's Corner  
on Webster Street and running thence with Webster Street S 70 1/2 E. forty  
(40) feet more or less to an iron pin at the intersection of Oaklawn Avenue  
and Webster Street thence N 35 E. one hundred and twenty (120) feet, more or  
less to an iron pin (now or formerly, Hicks corner), thence N 69 W. with  
Hicks corner line, Thirty-eight (38) feet, more or less to an iron pin, thence  
in a southeasterly direction seventy-five (75) feet more or less to a vent  
pipe at a toilet, or closet, thence in a Southern direction in a straight  
line forty-nine (49) feet, more or less, to the beginning corner on Webster  
Street, said being the same lot this day conveyed to me by W. H. Huff  
by deed dated the 15th day of December A. D. 1919.
