WHEREAS, I, the said Mrs. Lula Gresham
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

in the full and just sum of Five Thousand Five Hundred and Ten (\$250.00)
Dollars, to be paid as follows: \$836.67 in one two and three years
from date respectively, until paid

with interest thereon from March 5th 1920 at the rate of Seven per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount due to be immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of about 10% per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

bargain, sell and release unto the said Mary F. Goldsmith her heirs and assigns forever

All that tract or parcel of land containing 8-¹/₁₀ acres more or less, on
the Perry Road in the county and state aforesaid, adjoining lands of
Dr. Davis Thurman and A. J. New, northwest of the P. & N. Railway, on
the Perry Mountain Road and designated as subdivision "E" on the plat of
Thurman Land. (Plat Book A, Pages 494-5 P.M.C. office for
Greenville County. This being a portion of the land conveyed by
Mary F. Goldsmith to the Piedmont Savings and Investment
Company on February 25, 1911 by deed recorded in P.M.C. Office
in Vol. 21 Page 24 and later reconveyed by the said Piedmont Savings
and Investment Company to Mary F. Goldsmith, and being the same
lot of land this day conveyed to Mrs. Lula Gresham this mortgage being
given to secure balance due upon purchase price. The description
of said lot of land by metes and bounds is as follows:
