at a stake on the southeast corner of Williams and Pettigrew streets; thence north 64.56 east 63 feet with the south side of Pettigrew street to a stake corner of lot number 2; thence with the line of lot number 2 south 20.30 east 138.4 feet to a stake in the north line of a few foot alley; thence with the north line of the alley south 64.56 west 77 feet to a stake in Williams Street; thence with Williams street north 14.54 west 140 feet to the beginning corner.
