The Mortgage was Satisfied in Full on 29th Oct 1921 Harry A. Dargatzis Gertrude R. Harrison dec'd. James R. Bates

at the rate of seven per centum per annum until paid, interest to be computed and paid annually and if unpaid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal until paid. I have further promised and agreed to pay ten per cent of the whole amount due for attorney's fees, if said note be collected by an attorney or through legal proceedings of any kind, reference being hereunto had will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, N. P. Chiles in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof according to the terms of the said note and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Gertrude R. Harrison

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in Gantt's tract in Full Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

On the August 2nd day of 1910, I surveyed the following roads, known as a part of the Jones Place, beginning at a cross in a large hole on the bank of Reedy River, thence by a new line S. 73-10 W. 7.5 feet to an iron pin; thence by a new line S. 73-10 W. 7.5 feet to an iron pin in an old pond dam; thence by a new line S. 3-24 E. 542.2 feet to an iron pin in the edge of plantation road; thence with the road as a line S. 87-24 E. N. 466.5 feet to a bend; thence S. 66-48 N. 5-10 E. 5 feet to a bend in said road; thence S. 68-13 N. 3-24 E. 5 feet to an iron pin in the center of plantation road; thence with the Augusta Road S. 3-54 E. 1048 feet to a bend in Fork Shoals Road; thence with Fork Shoals Road S. 5-30 E. 194.6 feet to a stone on bank of said road, corner of Mrs. Lyda Morgan's property; thence with Mrs. Lyda Morgan's line N. 59-00 E. 374.6 feet to a stake on Reedy River; thence with the meanders of said river 799 feet to point of beginning, containing 88.48 acres more or less as per survey of R. C. Dalton under date of December 5, 1910.
