in hand well and truly paid at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and
released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *Hesiah Miller*

all that piece, parcel, tract or lot of land situated in *Butter*
Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina,

Containing one hundred and twenty-two and one-half acres more or less, adjoining lands of Washington Howell, E. Miller, E. Montgomery, W. D. Smith, lands formerly owned by Emilia Hughes, deceased, and others;

Beginning at a stake and running thence N. 50 W. 24.40 to a stake 3x0; thence S. 62 W. 49.25 to a stone; thence S. 28 1/2 E. 25.10 to a stone 3x0; thence N. 61 E. 50.00 to the beginning stake 3x, lying on the branch waters of Rocky Creek of Enoree River and being the same tract of land conveyed to me this day by Hesiah Miller and this mortgage is given to secure the balance of the purchase money thereof
