assigns all those two tracts of lands situate lying and being in Greenville County, South Carolina, South Township, containing 20 7/100 acres on Florida River and adjoining lands of H. A. Gambrell, James D. Wilson et al, bought of W. P. Cooper and T. C. Gower, about 5 miles from the City of Greenville.
