All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being just outside the city limits of the city of Greenville, S.C. being situate on the north west corner of Woodlawn Avenue and Marian Street, and being known as lot number 92 on a subdivision known as "Downwood," and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stake on the north west corner of Woodlawn Avenue and Marian Street and running thence N. 52-10 W. 140.9 feet to a stake, thence S. 15-20 E. 113 feet to a stake on Marian Street, thence N. 74-26 E. 85 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot this day conveyed to me by Lettie Vaughan and this mortgage is given to secure the balance of the purchase price.
