interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose the mortgage, and note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent on
whole amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as part thereof if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

bargain, sell and release unto the said Gertrude P. Harrison her heirs and assigns:
