J. F. Rott Martin of the county of Greenville state of South Carolina

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said J. F. Rott Martin  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am

in the full and just sum of Forty-one thousand (\$4,100.00)  
Dollars, to be paid as follows: Two Thousand dollars on or before Mar. 20 1921;  
Two Thousand dollars on or before Mar. 20 1922; Three Thousand  
dollars on or before Mar. 20 1923; Three Thousand dollars on or  
before Mar. 20 1924; and the balance on or before Mar. 20 1925  
with interest thereon from date at the rate of 1 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten percent of amount due

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the said J. F. Rott Martin  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said J. R. Jenkins

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

J. F. Rott Martin in hand well and truly paid by the said J. R. Jenkins

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said J. R. Jenkins

All that piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and being within  
the corporate limits of the city of Greenville state and county  
aforesaid. Beginning at a stake on the east side of Main  
Street at corner of lot formerly owned by M. J. Barr and running  
thence S. 70 E. 11 feet to stake, thence east 19 E. 12 feet to a  
stake, thence S. 68 1/2 E. 108 feet to a stake on a twenty foot alley  
thence N. 19 E. 15 1/2 feet to a stake, thence N. 71 W. 219 feet to a  
stake on Main Street, thence west Main Street S. 19 W. 25 1/2  
feet to the beginning corner, being the same lot of land conveyed  
to J. R. Jenkins by Henry T. Posley by his deed dated Jan 12 1906  
and recorded in R. M. C. Office in Vol. R.R.R. page 457 and being the  
same lot of land this day conveyed by said J. R. Jenkins to me  
excepting twelve (12) inches on the North side of said lot extending  
back eighty (80) feet conveyed by said J. R. Jenkins to A. L.  
Mill by deed dated April 2 1916 and recorded in R. M. C. Office  
for Greenville County in Vol. 20 at page 542, this mortgage  
being a purchase money mortgage given in part payment  
of purchase price.
