WHEREAS, I, S. P. Holland, the said, in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to.

Bank of Simpsonville in the full and just sum of Twenty-six Hundred Sixty five and 75/100 Dollars, to be paid. Jan. 1 - 1921 paid in full June 1922

with interest thereon from July 13th at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be computed and paid annually.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount so incensed by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of one-half per cent.

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt, any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in any of the said notes, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Bank of Simpsonville and its Successors or assigns,

All that certain tract of land situate in Custer Township County and state aforesaid, beginning at an iron pin at the intersection of Factory and Adams Mill roads, thence $97^{\circ} 18' \frac{1}{2} \text{ E}$ 1.00 h. bend, thence $n. 83^{\circ} \text{ E. } 51^{\frac{1}{2}} \text{ h. bend}$; thence $n. 34^{\circ} \text{ E. } 15.50 \text{ h. bend}$ n. $53^{\frac{1}{4}} \text{ E. } 10.00 \text{ h. bend}$; thence $n. 51^{\frac{1}{2}} \text{ E. } 7.25$ to iron pin in road J. W. Cox corner, thence continuing with the road $n. 41\frac{1}{4} \text{ E. } 4.48 \text{ h. bend}$; thence $n. 54\frac{1}{2} \text{ E. } 6.40$ to iron pin on Mr. Green's line, thence with said line $n. 29\frac{1}{4} \text{ E. } 8.78$ to pine stump 3X, thence $s. 20^{\circ} \text{ W. } 9.40$ to iron pin in Austin old Road, thence $s. 61\frac{2}{3} \text{ W. } 2.77$ to black gum 3X, thence $n. 86^{\circ} \text{ W. } 4.25$ to bend in Adams Mill Road, thence $n. 89\frac{1}{4} \text{ W. } 3.00$ to bend, thence $n. 85\frac{1}{2} \text{ W. } 2.81$ to bend, thence $s. 73\frac{2}{3} \text{ N. } 10.50$ to the beginning corner containing $61\frac{1}{4}$ acres more or less and being the land conveyed to Mrs. big William H. Austin, also all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land in County and state aforesaid adjoining lands of J. P.
