until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ~~one~~ ¹⁰⁰ per cent. on whole amount due thereon ~~for~~ ¹⁹²¹ besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

All that certain piece of land situated, lying and being in Ward one of the City of Greenville, County and state aforesaid, having the following lines and bounds to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the east side of Townee Street, on the Northwest corner of Thomas Sloane lot and running thence in a northerly direction along the east side of Townee Street one hundred and one (101) feet to a stake on the east side of Townee Street on the southwest corner of H. B. Harle lot; thence in a Easterly direction along H. B. Harle line - Two Hundred (200) feet to a stake on the north west corner of lot of land heretofore conveyed by E. A. Giffelin and L. B. Houston to A. H. Collingham; thence in a southerly direction along said A. H.
