with interest thereon from W. P. Henson at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That J. O. Stokes
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said W. P. Henson

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said J. O. Stokes

in hand well and truly paid by the said W. P. Henson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said W. P. Henson

All that certain parcel and tract of land situate lying and being in the state
and county aforesaid in Oneal Township, having the following meter and bounds
to-wit: Beginning at a stake in center of Jordan road, J. B. Henson and
Williams corner thence S. 43-3/4 W. 26.94 to a stone, thence S. 79-6. 18.50 to a
stone 34 thence N. 51-1/2 E. 82 Links to center of Jordan road thence up
said road N. 46 W. 2.00 to a bend thence N. 50 W. 4.00 to a bend in said
road, thence N. 47 W. 5.50 to a bend in said road, thence N. 52 W. 5.00
to a bend in road, thence N. 57 W. 1.84 to the beginning corner and contain-
ing 3 1/2 acres more or less and being the same tract conveyed to me by J. D.
