thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten percent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said W. P. Henson

and county aforesaid in Oneal Township, having the following metes and bounds  
to-wit: Beginning at a stake in center of Jordan road, J. B. Henson and  
William's corner thence S. 43° 34' W. 26.94 take stone, thence S. 79° E. 18.60 to a  
stone, 34' thence N. 57.25' E. 82' further to center of Jordan road, thence up  
said road m. 46 W. 2.00 to a bend thence m. 53 W. 4.00 to a bend in said  
road, thence m. 47 W. 5.50 to a bend in said road, thence m. 52 W. 5.00  
to a bend in road, thence m. 57 W. 1.80 to the beginning corner and contain-
