WHEREAS, I, the said Harriet S. Goldsmith  
in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

W.S. + H.L. Barr  
in the full and just sum of Two thousand (\$2,000<sup>00</sup>)  
Dollars, to be paid on or before November Full the 1920 with privilege to  
anticipate any or all payments at all time

with interest thereon from this 28<sup>th</sup> day of Jan 1922 at the rate of 6<sup>per cent</sup> per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full, all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney of his own choice  
ten percent of amount due besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which are secured under this mortgage) as incurred by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said Harriet S. Goldsmith  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said  
W.S. + H.L. Barr  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said  
Harriet S. Goldsmith  
in hand well and truly paid by the said  
W.S. + H.L. Barr

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said W.S. + H.L. Barr, their heirs and assigns;

All that lot of land situate on the Southeast side of  
Pettigree Street, in the City of Greenville, County, and State  
aforesaid, being known as lot No. 143 of Boyce Lawn  
addition, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book E.  
page 246, Beginning at an iron pin on Pettigree Street  
and runs thence S. 24.45 E. 186.5 feet to an iron pin  
thence 71 feet to an iron pin on the corner of lot  
142 thence N. 34.05 W. 118 feet to an iron pin thence  
N. 46.15 W. 75.3 feet to an iron pin on Pettigree Street  
thence with said Street 50 feet to the beginning corner  
being the same land conveyed to me by W. Stuart  
Barr and H.L. Barr, by deed dated the 1st of June 1920  
and not yet recorded.
