Saluda River, containing seventy-two acres, more or less, Beginning
at a stone on G. T. Willie line and running thence N. 46³/₄ E. 13. 50 to
an ash, thence N. 33¹/₂ W. 29. 40 to a stone, thence N. 61 W. 11. 75 to a
poplar on the branch, thence down the branch 25. 00 to a stone,
thence S. 70 E. 35. 00 to a stone, thence S. 20 W. 12. 20 to a stone on Willie
line thence S. 70 E. 12. 50 to the beginning corner and being a part of
