SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said D. M. Levi  
in and by a certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, I am well and truly indebted to

Henry P. McGee  
in the full and just sum of Six Hundred  
Dollars, to be paid one year from date hereof

with interest thereon from July 9th 1920 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of Ten per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said D. M. Levi  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

Henry P. McGee  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

D. M. Levi  
in hand well and truly paid by the said Henry P. McGee

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said Henry P. McGee his heirs and assigns,

All that piece parcel or lot of land situate lying and  
being in the County and State aforesaid and within  
the City of Greenville, fronting on David Street and  
designated as lot 501 on a plat and subdivision  
of land by Geo. H. Maxwell, and surveyed by W. D.  
Neves, having a frontage of 62 feet on David Street,  
and as to metes and bounds, course, distance  
etc., reference to Deed to me, <sup>filed in Full</sup> dated  
May 1st, 1914, and recorded Vol 192 Page 521 is  
hereby cited for a full description.
