All that piece parcel or lot of land, situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid, in the City of Greenville, and in Ward Two, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake corner of Lavinia Avenue and Franklin Avenue and running thence with Lavinia Avenue in a northwesterly direction sixty-eight (68) feet to a stake thence in an easterly direction one hundred and seventy-two (172) feet to a stake on Franklin Avenue thence with Franklin Avenue in a southerly direction fifty (50) feet to a stake thence in a southwesterly direction with said Franklin Avenue one hundred and fifty-five (155) feet to a stake at the beginning corner. Being a portion of the lot conveyed to me by J. F. Hunt, R. J. Rowley, and E. F. S. Rowley on the 16th day of October 1910, said deed being recorded in R.M.C. office in and for Greenville County in Vol. 13 at page 535. Said lot being a portion of the lot shown by plat made by W. A. Adams said plat being of record in R.M.C. office in Plat Book "C" at page 5. Reference to said plat is hereby avoided.
