I, J.F. Lynch

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said J.F. Lynch  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

W.R. Hale  
in the full and just sum of Two hundred fifty and no/100  
Dollars, to be paid Jan. 1st, 1921

with interest thereon from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or  
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue  
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of fifty dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to  
the amount due on said note, to be collected as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being  
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That J.F. Lynch  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

W.R. Hale  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said

J.F. Lynch  
in hand well and truly paid by the said W.R. Hale

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,  
bargain, sell and release unto the said W.R. Hale, his heirs and assigns forever: All those certain

pieces, parcels or lots of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid  
on the Spartanburg Road about one and one-half miles from Greenville County Court House,  
known as lots numbers three, four, five and six on the subdivision of John C. Thompsons  
property, each lot having a frontage of 60 feet on said road with a depth of two hundred  
feet. And being the same lots conveyed to me by Annie D. Smith and B.H. Deason my said deed  
being of record Vol. - - - page - - -, reference to same is hereby craved. This mortgage  
is junior to a mortgage in the sum of Eighteen hundred Dollars.

"All that lot or parcel of land situated, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid  
and in Chick Springs Township about five miles Northeast of the City of Greenville on the  
National Highway at Camp Sevier and being a portion of the E.M. Wharton sub-division as shown  
by plat made by W.D. Neves for White and Todd, beginning at a stake on the National Highway  
point corners of lots Nos. 1 and 2 and running thence with joint lines of lots Nos. 1 and 2  
N. 8-15 W. 68-1 feet to a stake on right of way of P & N. R.R.; thence 68 W. along said  
right of way 205 feet to a stake on the right of way of P & N. RR; thence with joint lines of  
Lots Nos. 2 and 3- 8 - 15 E. 63-4 feet to a stake on National Highway W. 81-45 E. 20 feet  
to the beginning corner and being described as Lot 2 on said plat made by W.D. Neves,  
dated July 1917 and being one of the lots conveyed to me by C.M. Todd, Trustee by his deed  
recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, S.C. in Vol. 42, at page 346.
