with interest thereon from January 1st of 1925 until paid in full, per cent. per annum to be computed and paid quarterly.

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note shall become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten percent of indebtedness plus expenses and costs of suit.

attorney fees, which are to be added to the mortgage debt, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

All that piece parcel of tract of land situate in State + County aforesaid, Greenville, on waters of Barbare Branch + Clear Creek, which is a tributary of South Tiger River + adjoining land of J. W. Rose, Chet Edwards + myself + being part of the said land conveyed to Mrs Laura R. Williams by Lewis H. Fleming Dec. 10, 1888, and recorded in the office of Register of Deeds Conveyance of said County in Book 10 page 213 + having the following metes + bounds viz. Beginning on an iron pin 34, which is the 34 of J. W. Rose's land + running thence with J. W. Rose's line S. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ W. 17.55 chaine to an iron pin on J. W. Rose's line, thence with this line of J. W. Rose S. 65 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 10.13 chaine to a maple on Barbare Branch thence down said branch with a north easterly course 46.00 chaine to the junction of Barbare Branch + Clear Creek; thence up said creek with a north-westerly course 5.07 chaine to an iron pin 34 on south branch of said creek; thence S. 22 $\frac{5}{8}$ W. 25.60 chaine to the beginning 34 containing thirty-eight and 45/100 (38.45) acres, more or less.
