Dollars, to be paid as follows One hundred & no/100 Dollars on Nov 24th, 1921 and One hundred
fifty and no/100 Dollars on Nov. 24th, 1922.

with interest thereon from this date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and any portion of principal or
interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue
thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent besides all costs and expense of collection, to be added to
the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt, or any portion thereof,
be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being
thereunto had, as will more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said T.H. Jones, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land

situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid in Chick Springs Township,
adjoining lands of R.L. Miller, John Wood and others and having the following metes and
bounds to-wit/: Beginning on post-oak on Miller's line; thence N. 82-5/8 W. 10.15 to
pine stump; thence N. 81-5/8 W. 8.75 to pine; thence S. 45- E. 2.78 to pine; thence
S. 31-2/3 E. 4.05 to stone; thence N. 48-1/2 E. 6.27 to stump; thence S. 52 E. 8.67 to
stone; thence N. 39 E. 5.17 to the beginning corner and containing four and one-fourth
4-1/4 acres, more or less. This being the same land conveyed to me by W.H. Few by deed
