Dollars, to be paid In four annual installments, \$800.00 December 17th 1921
\$800.00 Dec. 17th 1922; \$800.00 Dec. 17th 1923 and \$600.00 Dec. 17-1924

with interest thereon from the date of the making of the mortgage at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

and if any part of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose the mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10 per cent

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.
