J. E. Bryson of the City and County of Greenville in said
STATE SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, *J. E. Bryson*, the mortgagor hereinabove named

in and by *me* certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, *Ann* well and truly
indebted to *me* the mortgagee hereinafter named *H. C. Alexander*

Purchased hundred (\$1200.00) DOLLARS,
to be paid in three equal annual installments of four hundred
dollars (\$400.00) each payable in one, two and three years
after date respectively,

with interest thereon from *this date* at the rate of *eight* per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid *annually* until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal;
and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the
option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent of the amount due thereon
besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the
same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind or
if any part of the money due on said note be not paid when due (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereto
had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That *J. E. Bryson*, the said mortgagor,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof to the mortgagee *me* hereinabove named, according to the terms of the said
note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to *me* the said mortgagor
in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagor.

Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

H. C. Alexander and his heirs and assigns: All that certain lot
piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the state of
South Carolina and county of Greenville in the city of Greenville
beginning at a stake on St. John Street, one hundred and fifty
nine (159) feet and nine (9) inches from Green Avenue, and
running thence N. 21° 2' E. two hundred and seventy-five (275) feet
to a stake (which stake is two hundred and forty-eight feet from
an iron pin on Green Avenue); thence N. 72° W. fifty-two (52) feet
and some inches more or less, to a stake, thence S. 21° 2' W. two
hundred and seventy-eight (278) feet to a stake on St. John Street
thence with St. John Street S. 76° 2' E. fifty-two (52) feet to the
beginning corner.

This is the same lot of land this day conveyed to me, the said
J. E. Bryson by the said *H. C. Alexander* and this mortgage is given
to secure the payment of a portion of the purchase money there-
for, but it is junior to a first mortgage this day given by me
to Mechanics Perpetual Building & Loan Association, covering the
same property which is also a purchase money mortgage and is
given to secure a note for two thousand, one hundred dollars.
