at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold and
Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said J. J. Bruce, his

heirs and assigns, all that certain piece, parcel
or tract of land situate, lying and being in Oak-
lawn Township, Greenville County, state aforesaid
containing one hundred and twenty-two (122) acres
more or less and having the following lines,
metes and bounds, to wit; Beginning at a stone
N. M. iiii in Cooley's line, and running thence
S. 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 30.90 to a stone 3 x m. in Robert's line;
thence N. 28 $\frac{3}{4}$ E. 40.23 to a stake 3 x 0 m. stone 3 x n
thence S. 88 $\frac{1}{4}$ W. 47.25 to a stone N. M. iiii in
Cooley's line; thence with Cooley's line S. 6 W. 25.00 to
the beginning, being part of a tract of land con-
