Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said S. C. Baskin his heirs and assigns forever

All that certain lot of land on the east side of Jones Street in the third Ward of the city of Greenville, County of Greenville in the state of South Carolina and having the following lines and bounds, to-wit: Beginning at a stake on the east side of Jones Street corner of the lot owned by S.O. Shelton to Matie Givens, thence with Jones Street in a southwesterly direction 50 feet to stake, corner of lot conveyed by W.A. Barton to Matie A. Mc Gee, thence with the line of the last mentioned lot 120 feet to stake on Meridith's line thence along Meridith's line in a northeasterly direction 50 feet to line of lot conveyed by S.O. Shelton to Rita Thompson, thence with the line of Rita Thompson's lot 62 feet to Mrs. Givens' line, thence with her line along the same course 50 feet to the beginning corner and being the same lot of land conveyed to S.C. Baskin by W.R. Doyle and E.C. Doyle in their joint right and E.C. Doyle as Trustee under the will of Dr. C.C. Jones, deceased by deed dated March 5th 1918, recorded in Clerk's office for Greenville County S.C. in deed Book Volume 50 at page 76 and by the said S.C. Baskin conveyed to me by deed delivered simultaneously herewith and to be recorded.

Mortgagor herein agrees to keep the buildings on the premises above described insured against loss or damage by fire in some reputable Insurance Company, agreeable to mortgagee for the sum of Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars and to assign the policy so obtained to mortgagee for his additional security and protection, and in the event that mortgagor fails so to do, mortgagee shall have the right to insure said buildings and add the amount so paid to the face of the indebtedness.

It is mutually understood and agreed that in the event of default in the payment when due of any portion of the indebtedness secured hereby, the whole debt secured hereby shall become immediately due and payable at the option of the holder hereof.
