All that parcel or lot of land, situate in the County and State aforesaid, on the Easley Bridge Road, near the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a corner of Lot No. 8 and Easley Bridge Road; thence S. 32-3/4 W. 70 feet along said Easley Bridge Road, corner of lot No. 10 thence S. 43 1/2 E. 190 feet to the corner of lot No. 10; thence N. 49 E. 70 feet to corner of lot No. 8; thence along line of lot No. 8, N 43 1/2 W. 190 feet to the beginning corner, containing 13,000 square feet, more or less, and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by N.
