For value received I promise to pay A. H. Donaldson or order the sum of Two Hundred no 100 Dollars twelve months after date with interest thereon from date hereof at the rate of 8% per annum to be computed and paid annually until paid in full; All interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal.

And I hereby agree, that if at any time any portion of said principal or interest shall be past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by this note shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon this note and any collaterals given to secure the same, for the purpose of collecting said principal and interest, with cost and expenses or of protecting any security connected therewith. And I further agree hereby that if any part of the money due hereon be not paid when due, or if this note be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection or if this debt or any part thereof be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind an attorney's fee of ten percent besides all cost and expenses incident upon such collection, shall be added to the amount due upon this note and reference being thereto had, will more fully appear .....
