Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release, unto the said W.O. Johnson, all that tract.....

Home Place, known as the Center land, containing One hundred fifty acres, more or less,
bounded on the North by Levy Ward, on the East by the Butler land, on the South by
