At this place, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

J. W. S. Carpenter his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: all that piece parcel or lots of land situated, lying and being in the state and County aforesaid, within the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, and having the following metes and bounds: Beginning at a stone on the old Spartanburg road, and running thence N. 84° 1/2' E. 2.30 to a stone, thence N. 3 E. 45 links to pine, thence N. 28 E. 158' to a stone, thence N. 19 W. 89 links to stone, thence S. 57 W. 60 links to stone, thence N. 44 W. 134 to stone on old Spartanburg road, thence along said road S. 24 W. 293 to a stone, thence along the old Spartanburg road S. 10° 12' W. 90 links to the beginning corner as shown by a plan of the same by J. K. Dickeson, Surveyor, on the 26th day of November 1890 more particularly described in a Deed which is recorded in the R. M. C. office for the County and state aforesaid in Book FFF, page 768 and contains 13 acres and five perches.

Also all that certain piece parcel or lot of land in the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, County of Greenville and state of South Carolina, situated on both sides of a small branch, tributary of Pickland Creek, and on the east side of said creek fronting on the old Spartanburg road, beginning at a stone on said road and running thence S. 24 W. 91 to stone, thence S. 55 W. 2.22 to pine stump and stone on Hilliard Dawkins line, thence N. 28 E. 67 1/2 links to old pine stump and stone also Hilliard Dawkins corner, thence N. 19 W. 89 links to others on bank of branch of Delia Griffins corner, thence along the east bank S. 57 W. 60 links to stone, also Delia Griffins corner, thence N. 44 W. 134 to the beginning corner on old Spartanburg road, and adjoining the lands of Delia Griffins, Hilliard Dawkins and others, containing one ~~fourth~~ acre more or less.
