TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, Aline P. Milan, of said County and State SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, I, the mortgagor, hereinabove named

in and by MY certain PROMISSORY note in writing, of even date with these presents, and well and truly

indebted to the mortgagee S hereinafter named, W.G. Gresham, J.N. Bell and D.W. Cochrane

in the full and just sum of Two hundred and twenty-five (\$225.00) DOLLARS,
to be paid on or before the tenth day of October A.D. 1923

with interest thereon from this date at the rate of seven per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal;
and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option
of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fees of twenty-five dollars

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the
same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind or
if any part of the money due on said note be not paid when due (all of which is secured under this mortgage), as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto
had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said mortgagor, in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better
securing the payment thereof to the mortgagee hereinabove named according to the terms of the said
note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said mortgagor,
in hand well and truly paid by the said mortgagee S

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

W.G. Gresham, J.N. Bell and D.W. Cochrane and their heirs and assigns, all that certain lot, piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, in the County and Township of Greenville, about two or three miles from the City of Greenville, east of the Augusta Road, being known and designated as the east half of lot No. 20, according to plat of Ables and Basor property, recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County and State in Plat Book "E", at page 153, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a stake on the South side of Riverside Drive ninety (90) feet westward from the west side of Ridge Drive (said stake being on the north-west corner of Lot No. 19 already belonging to Mrs. Milan) and running thence along said Riverside Drive S. 64° 35' W. thirty-seven (37) feet to a stake on said Drive in the center of the front line of lot No. 20, as shown on said plat; thence about S. 25° or 26° E. about one hundred and eighty-three (183) feet to a stake in the middle of the rear line of said lot No. 20 and in the middle of the rear line of lot No. 49; thence about S. 65° or 70° E. thirty-eight and a quarter (38-1/4) feet along line of lot No. 49 to a stake on joint corner of lots 19, 20, 49 and 50; thence about N. 25° or N. 26° E. one hundred and eighty-three and seven-tenths (183.7) feet along line of lot 19 to the beginning corner. This is the same land conveyed to the said Mrs. Alien-P. Milan by said W.G. Gresham, J.N. Bell and D.W. Cochrane; this mortgage being given to secure the balance of the purchase money therefor.
